
Supplemental Information for 372-085 or 1B2732 Air Filter Assembly (no vent tube) BN1, BN2 (rear carb), BN4 (front carb) 372-095 or 1B2733 Air Filter Assembly (w/vent tube)

BN1, BN2 (front carb), BN4 (rear carb)









The Austin Healey BN1, BN2 and early BN4 used a wire mesh filter
assembly (1B2732, 1B2733) made by Burgess. We offer an excellent
reproduction of the outer housing which comes from England. Each
assembly includes the top and bottom plate, and the distinctive outer screen
of perforated metal. All of the pieces are painted black. The 372-095 has the
vent tube, and both come with the Burgess Air Filter disc.


The original element (Fig 6) had an inner and outer layer of mesh screening, and the space between the two screens was filled with copper wool. There was a top & bottom plate which had a rubber seal in a groove that pressed against the top and bottom of the air filter assembly. The Burgess filter elements have been unavailable for many years, and rather than supply the housing without any element at all, we include a 372-040 (AHH5442), a reproduction of the Coopers type wire mesh / felt air filter element.



The 372-040 Coopers Type filter element will fit into the Burgess housing, and makes a reasonable vintage looking replacement.







Upgrading the Filter Element

The oiled wire mesh air filters from Burgess and Coopers represented the state-of-the-art for the 1950's. In terms of performance, the oiled mesh filters cannot be compared to a modern air filter. Time and technology march on. We can supply a 223-006 K&N air filter element that fits inside the Burgess housing. The K&N filters are pleated, and they use a wire mesh on the exterior. The K&N filter is an excellent blend of outstanding filter performance and minimal restriction. They can be cleaned and oiled for a lifetime of service. The K&N filter elements are sold individually. When installed, the original perforated metal screen make it nearly impossible to see the K&N filter element inside- preserving the look of the original air filters. Figure 11 shows the K&N element inside an original housing.



If you want, reproduction Burgess air filter housings are available with K&N filter elements instead of the Coopers type elements. See 372-086 Air Filter Assembly (no vent tube) for BN1, BN2 (rear carb), and BN4 (front carb). See 372-095 Air Filter Assembly (w/vent tube) for BN1, BN2 (front carb), and BN4 (rear carb)
