Installation Instructions

CONTENTS: one repair panel, adhesive and instructions

TOOLS REQUIRED: razor blade, ammonia based cleaner (window cleaner with ammonia will work), masking tape, heavy soft objects

- 1.** Thoroughly clean your dash and the under side of the repair panel using ammonia based cleaner. All vinyl conditioners, waxes or oils must be removed or the panel will not stick.
- 2.** If the dash has cracks that have lifted, leaving high spots; use a razor blade or similar tool to cut away the high spots. Be careful to cut only in areas that will be covered by the the repair panel.
- 3.** Check the fit. Older dashes may have changed from their original shape. Therefore, check the fit of the repair panel before applying adhesive. You may find it necessary to make a small adjustment by trimming with a razor blade.
- 4.** On the underside of the panel, apply adhesive around the outside edge, 1/2" away from the edge. Caution: Application of adhesive anywhere except on the edges will void the warranty.
- 5.** Use masking tape to tape down the edges as necessary. Place heavy objects, such as telephone books, on the repair panel to ensure a tight fit.
- 6.** Allow the dash to set for 24 hours in the garage or shed area while the adhesive cures. After 24 hours have passed, remove the tape.

The plastic used in Moss Motors dashboard repair panels is specially formulated, high-heat resistant plastic. It has been tested under the most extreme heat conditions and will withstand dashboard surface temperatures of the summer desert sun without wrinkling or warping.
